Address from Director, NICPR

Greetings to All for the year 2023!.

The year began on a positive note as we celebrated the 44th Annual Day of our institute. Over the last few years, NICPR has made significant strides in developing and validating innovative and improved strategies for cervical, oral, and breast cancer screening in the country. Lately, the institute has expanded its research domain to other cancers including esophageal, gall bladder, head and neck, ovarian, endometrial and prostate as well. The institute's health promotion clinic is carrying out screening for risk factors for non-communicable diseases. Tobacco cessation counselling point is another important feature of our Health Promotion Clinic where behavioral and non-behavioral interventions are carried out to assist individuals to quit tobacco.

Community awareness and screening programs are being organized regularly especially among high-risk groups like prisoners and hard-to-reach areas for early diagnosis of lesions and appropriate management. Besides patient service, NICPR has also been working towards building a trained comprehensive workforce all over the country for screening of cancers in the community. Over the last 6 months, NICPR has conducted training for Medical Officers, staff nurses, and pathologists in screening for common cancers.

The Institute celebrated Republic Day, Women's Day and Yoga Day with full gusto and organized various activities with the participation of young and elders alike. The Staff and faculty also participated enthusiastically to observe and spread the message on the occasion of Oral Cancer Awareness month, World No Tobacco Day, National Statistics Day etc. Workshops and webinars have been organized to improve Quality of Medical Research and protocol Writing. NICPR scientists have been awarded several new research projects and are working enthusiastically towards their goals.




INSTITUTIONAL ACTIVITIES (HEALTH DAYS/EVENTS/SEMINARS/TRAINING COURSES ORGANISED



Her talk emphasized that outcome of childhood cancer in low middle-income countries continues to be poor primarily due to late detection and initiation of treatment. She emphasised on increased primary care physician sensitization for quicker referral to specialized centers that may mitigate the delay and improve outcomes.





• February 21-22, 2023: 2nd National Consultation on Smokeless Tobacco Control in India. Number of participants/ trainees: 130








$15-16^{th}$ March 2023: Hands-on Workshop "Molecular Docking, Pharmacaphore modeling and Machine Learning"


WORLD ORAL HEALTH DAY 20th March 2023

Topics covered included early signs and symptoms of TB, diagnostic tests, complications of tuberculosis,' the importance of completing the treatment, "TB mukt Bharat", Nikshay mitra, Nikshay portal etc. Students were also given a chance to clear their doubts regarding TB. They were encouraged to motivate their relatives and neighbors to avail government facilities for free diagnosis and treatment.


31st May 2023: World No Tobacco day

The WHO FCTC Knowledge Hub on Smokeless Tobacco, ICMR-NICPR successfully organized a 'Sensitization activity of Institute Staffs on Tobacco Free Institute Initiative' from 17th May to 23rd May 2023 at National Institute of Cancer Prevention and Research (ICMR-NICPR) for all the departments in groups such as housekeeping, maintenance, horticulturCe, security, accounts, store, administrative and project staff of the institute. With these more than 100 staff have been sensitized within the Institute. Information about Govt. guidelines on Tobacco Free Institute Initiative and supporting guidance on tobacco cessation available at the Institute was provided.
